LEARN... about new tools and solution-oriented strategies that others have used to successfully drive major system change in fields ranging from software engineering and space technology to business and basic research.

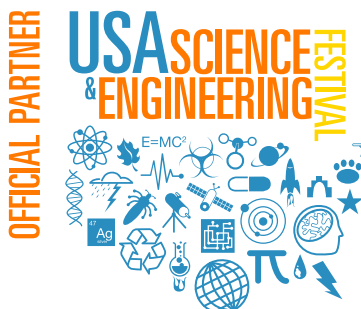
